

HJW03 OPALA FLOOR LAMP MIDI





The HJW03 Opala Floor Lamp Midi was designed by Hans J. Wegner in 1973 as part of a larger lighting series created for Hotel Scandinavia in Copenhagen.

The series features a bold, almost futuristic aesthetic — with subtly tilted shades and clean, linear forms.

The Opala floor lamp is distinguished by its asymmetrical opal acrylic shade and a painted aluminium top.

It emits a pleasant, focused light downward while softly illuminating the surrounding space through the translucent shade.

Well-suited for living rooms and lounge areas.
