HØRSHOLM CHURCH, HØRSHOLM, DENMARK

On the occasion of the church's 200th anniversary in 2024, the interior was carefully restored under the direction of [ERIK Architects](#), specialists in the conservation of historic buildings. Inspired by C.F. Hansen's neoclassical vision, the church was brought back to its original architectural essence – while integrating discreet, contemporary improvements.

Colours and materials were reinstated in calm, authentic tones. Lighting plays a key architectural role: [Tulip pendants](#) in the nave, [Dybøl ceiling luminaires](#) in the aisles, and custom-designed brass wall fixtures from Okholm Lighting in the gallery, combining functionality with atmosphere. A continuous LED frieze accentuates the vaulted ceiling and the barrel vaults above the altar and organ, creating a softly graduated illumination.

The result is a harmonious synthesis of light, colour, and architecture – with respect for history and a clear focus on present-day needs.
